- Categories: <u>8 & under</u>, <u>10 & under</u>, <u>12 & under</u>, <u>14 & under</u>, <u>16 & under</u>, and <u>17 & over</u>.
- Trophies awarded in each category; past winners perform in a separate Winners Program.
- Teachers are expected to attend and help with event duties.
- Dress Code: Dresses/elegant outfits for females; dress pants, shirt, and shoes for males (no sports shoes).
